What does Enrych Assist offer?

Our Enrych Assist service is for people who want regular one-to-one support with their day-to-day activities from a personal assistant they can trust and depend on.

Personal Assistants can help with a variety of activities such as getting out and about, jobs around the house, gardening, shopping, going to appointments, and whatever you need to do.

All our Personal Assistants are trained by Enrych and have an enhanced DBS (formally CRB) check. We carefully match our PAs to meet each client's requirements.

How can I get support from Enrych Assist?

We accept referrals from healthcare professionals, local authorities or directly from individuals. The only criteria is that we are able to support your particular needs. **Please note we do not provide personal care.**

We support people who have funded support from the local authority via a framework or a cash payment, and we also support people who pay for services themselves.

What will my PA do?

This will depend on your Support Plan (if you have one) and your requirements. But in all cases, PAs are there to enable you to live as independently as possible and to live your life, your way.
